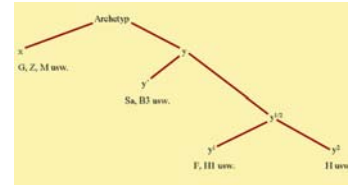

- o Lachmann's goal was to create an authorial original that is now absent but present in the manuscript tradition

New Philology / New Phylogeny

- o New Philology
 - Renounces hierarchy of texts
 - Variety in transmission
 - Instability of medieval texts
- o New Phylogeny
 - Focus on interrelations and groupings in order to establish a text

Anthonij Dees / "Unrooted Structures"

- o Stemma has no root
 - Genealogical dependence is no longer the necessary conclusion
 - Simply depicts relationships between variants in a group of mss

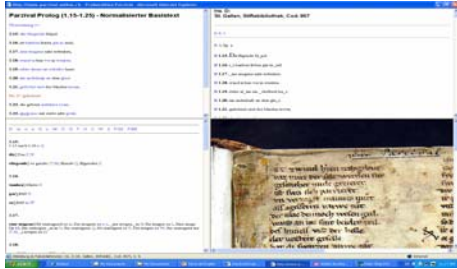
